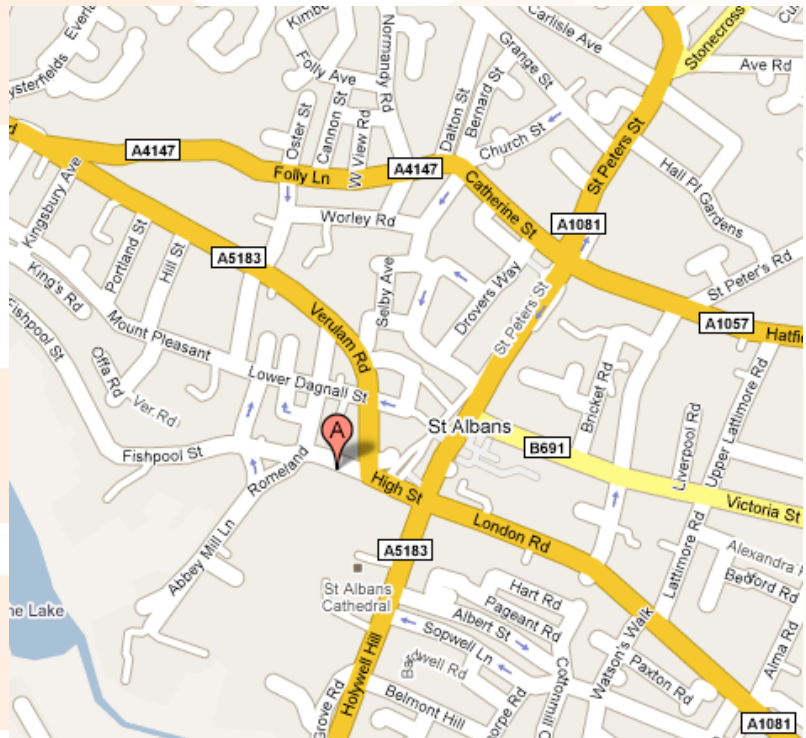

By Rail

The closest station is St Albans City. Trains travel from central London (St Pancras International), using First Capital Connect. At peak times trains run every 15 minutes. Some non-stop St Albans to St Pancras International take just 19 minutes.

By Car

M25 Clockwise – J21A. Follow the A405, then A5183 to St Albans town centre. From Holywell Hill, turn left at the traffic lights into High St. George Street is next left. Parking is difficult in George St, please see 'Parking' below.

M25 Anti-clockwise – J22. Follow A1081 (London Rd) to St Albans town centre. At the traffic lights, London Rd becomes High St. George Street is next left. Parking is difficult in George St, please see 'Parking' below.

M1 Northbound – J6. Follow the A405, then A5183 to St Albans town centre. From Holywell Hill, turn left at the traffic lights into High St. George Street is next left. Parking is difficult in George St, please see 'Parking' below.

M1 Southbound – J7. Follow the A5183 to St Albans town centre. From Holywell Hill, turn left at the traffic lights into High St. George Street is next left. Parking is difficult in George St, please see 'Parking' below.

A1(M) – J3. Follow A414 to St Albans. Follow A1081 (London Rd) to St Albans town centre. At the traffic lights, London Rd becomes High St. George Street is next left. Parking is difficult in George St, please see 'Parking' below.
